



Becoming a Contributor to the Good Men Project

When you want to build writer's social proof, you'll want to start with publications that don't require you to have been published anywhere else.

The Good Men Project is a great publication that gets ten million monthly visitors. It has categories for all topics.

You don't have to be a man to write for the Good Men Project — women are welcome.

You don't have to, and shouldn't, submit articles with "man" keywords in the title if it doesn't make sense.

You have to be ready to submit a full article. When you are ready, you would submit here: <https://goodmenproject.submittable.com/submit>

You would check the box based on if you're a first timer or have submitted before. The form will ask you for all the required information.

One important thing you'll need is your Gravatar email address. If you're not sure what that is, head here and create your account: <https://en.gravatar.com/>. Upload a photo.

The Good Men Project and a few other publications pull the bio photo from Gravatar.

You don't have to send a photo for your article and shouldn't unless it relates to a personal story in the article.

Share your GMP articles with you network — it's a big win.

Add the Good Men Project in your "experience section" on LinkedIn, and as a "job" on your Facebook profile. It pushes that as a notification to your network.
