For some publications, they will have a staff page: <https://www.entrepreneur.com/staff>.

This page is going to be hidden because they don't want their editors to be overwhelmed.

You will have to Google the publication's name and editors to see what pulls up. Here is an example on AskMen: <https://www.askmen.com/recess/opinions/contact-us.html>

Some publications have a "Masthead." This is a traditional publishing term. You can see an example on Time Magazine: <https://time.com/time-masthead/> and Fast Company: <https://www.fastcompany.com/staff-masthead>
